## Fatal Traffic Crash

At 8:47 P.M., Sunday, March 11, 2018, the Schaumburg Police and Fire Departments responded to a report of a traffic crash involving serious injuries near 1424 Wiley Road. The traffic crash involved a 2010 Subaru Outback.

The driver of the Subaru, Graham W. Fath, a 16 year old male from unincorporated Schaumburg, was pronounced deceased at the scene. There are no indications of involvement by any other vehicles or persons at this time.

The preliminary investigation indicates the 2010 Subaru, which was being driven by Fath, was traveling eastbound Wiley Road when the vehicle crossed into the westbound lane, left the roadway and struck a utility pole. Fath was ejected from the vehicle and pronounced deceased at the scene. Speed is believed to be a factor in the cause of the accident. The vehicle caught fire and was extinguished by Schaumburg Fire Department. The Schaumburg Police Department is investigating this accident with the assistance of the Major Case Assistance Team (MCAT) Serious Traffic Accident Reconstruction Team.
