Schaumburg Police Department St Patrick's Day *Drive Sober or Get Pulled Over* Enforcement Results

The Schaumburg Police Department, alongside the Illinois Department of Transportation, the Illinois State Police and local law enforcement agencies across the state completed a successful *Drive Sober or Get Pulled Over* campaign that coincided with the St Patrick's Day weekend. From March 16th through March 19th, the Schaumburg Police Department conducted traffic safety enforcement reminding motorists to buckle up and not drive impaired. In doing so, they kept local roads safer during the St Patrick's Day weekend.

During the St Patrick's Day Campaign, the Schaumburg Police Department issued the following:

- **10** seat belt citations
- **14** distracted driving citations
- **6** speeding citations
- **3** suspended/revoked licenses
- **5** uninsured motorists
- **1** graduated license violation

** Non grant enforcement results include 28 distracted driving citations and 41 speeding citations.
