Off-duty officer involved in a traffic accident

At 1:35 A. M., Friday, June 22, 2018, the Schaumburg Police Department responded to a traffic accident west bound Schaumburg Road east of Hilltop Drive. The accident involved a black Cadillac which struck a tree on the north parkway. The driver was not injured and refused medical treatment at the scene. There were no other persons inside the vehicle at the time of the accident.

The driver was identified as, John Raftery, an off duty Schaumburg Police Officer. Cook County Sheriff's Police Department responded to conduct the traffic accident. CCSPD conducted the traffic accident investigation and Raftery was placed under arrest for DUI.

Schaumburg Police Officer, John Raftery, is a 28 year veteran of the police department. Effective today, Officer John Raftery has resigned.
