Schaumburg Police Charge Man with Criminal Sexual Assault

The Cook County State's Attorney's Office approved one charge of Criminal Sexual Assault, a Class 1 Felony against Ronald Williams.

On June 7, 2018, Schaumburg Police were made aware of an allegation of a Sexual Assault which occurred in 2001. The offense took place at Schaumburg High School between a male teacher and a 17 year old female student. The teacher, identified as Ronald Williams, engaged in a sexual relationship with a 17 year old student while he was in a position of authority. Williams is not currently employed by Schaumburg High School and ended his employment with them in 2002. Williams turned himself in to the Schaumburg Police on September 26, 2018.

Williams will appear for a bond hearing at the Cook County 3rd District Court in Rolling Meadows today, September 26, 2018, at 1:30 p.m.
