Burglary at Target

On January 10, 2019, at approximately 22:15pm, three (3) men entered the Target at 1235 E. Higgins Road. While one of the men distracted the electronics area employee, the other two men broke into a display cabinet containing Apple products. The offenders took approximately (25) Apple iPads and (25) Apple Watches. The estimated value of the items taken was \$23,750. The offenders exited the store and fled in an unknown direction. The Schaumburg Police are continuing with this investigation.

The suspects were described as three African American males, all wearing dark clothing, and all appeared to be in their mid 20's. One of the suspects was described to be wearing an Army green coat.
