Suspicious Incident – (Second) Possible Child Luring

On May 26, 2019, at approximately 9:35am, an officer was dispatched to the area of 2500 W. Holmes Way to speak with a mother and her juvenile son about a delayed report. The mother and son reported he was skateboarding westbound on Holmes Way, towards the 2500 block, on May 25th at approximately 2pm when he was approached by a male black driver in a silver vehicle who offered him a ride. The juvenile declined a ride and the subject drove away. The suspect is described as being in his 30's, with jaw length dreadlocks and driving a silver vehicle. The suspect and vehicle from this incident appear to be similar to the suspect and suspect's vehicle from the previously reported child luring incident that occurred on May 23rd 2019. The Schaumburg Police Department is investigating this incident and added additional patrols throughout the village.
