## Schaumburg Police Investigation results in Disorderly Conduct Arrest

On September 10, 2019, at approximately 6:00pm, the Schaumburg Police Department responded to the 1900 block of Whittier Lane, to investigate a threat complaint. Officers were provided a surveillance audio and video recording of a subject outside of the victims' residence making threatening statements. The suspect, Phillip Jaster, 53 yoa, was subsequently arrested at his home, on Whittier Court. During the course of the arrest Jaster provided consent for a search of his residence. No firearms were located.

Jaster was transported to the Schaumburg Police Department for further investigation. As a result of this investigation, he was charged with Disorderly Conduct, a Class C Misdemeanor. Jaster was able to post the required bond and was released from custody. As a condition of his bond, he was ordered to have no contact with the victims.
