Suspicious Incident

The Schaumburg Police Department is investigating a suspicious incident involving a battery that occurred approximately 12:42pm, Friday, August 9, 2019. A female exited a vehicle and entered a jewelry store in the 1700 block of Woodfield Road. As the woman stood in the store, a male occupant from the same vehicle entered the store and a physical altercation occurred. The male escorted her outside where another physical altercation occurred. Both entered the car and left in an unknown direction. The Schaumburg Police Department is requesting the public's assistance in locating the female.



The victim is described as:

Female/Black,
Thin build, 18-20 years old
With long, black hair and wearing excessively long,
false eyelashes

Last seen wearing: A black t-shirt with white print
"BLACK LIVES MATTER" on the front, and
shorts

The offender is described as:

Male/Black
Thin build, approximately 5'10
20-30 years old
