## Schaumburg Police Investigation Results in Felony Arrest for Aggravated Discharge of a Firearm

On Sunday, September 8, 2019, at 11:44am, the Schaumburg Police Department responded to a parking lot in the 2300 block of W. Bode Road to investigate a report of shots fired. Upon arrival, officers discovered a 26 year old male victim, with gunshot wounds to both of his legs. Schaumburg Fire Department transported the victim to Lutheran General Hospital for treatment.

Detectives determined the victim was involved in a dispute with the suspect, later identified as, Jacob M. Taylor. On October 18, 2019 Taylor surrendered himself to detectives. The Cook County State's Attorney's office reviewed the case and authorized the following charge:

- Aggravated Discharge of a Firearm (Class 1 Felony)
